ROSEBERY SCHOOL PSA 100 CLUB RULES

The Rosebery 100 Club is a Small Society Lottery under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005 Section 19 and its purpose is to raise funds for the benefit of Rosebery School.

1. Membership of the club is open to all parents, staff and friends of Rosebery School who are over 16 years old.
2. The monthly prize money is 40% of the membership fees taken that month.
3. For £12 per year (£1 per monthly draw) members are allocated one unique number. Members may hold more than one number. Payments must be made by cheque or standing order. To qualify for inclusion in the monthly draw, payment must have been received by the 15th of that month.
4. No member will be included in the monthly draw if their payment has not been received. If a member does not pay for three months, their number will be reallocated.
5. It is the responsibility of each member to ensure that changes to their contact details are registered with the 100 Club Administrator. If the winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be put into PSA funds after six months.
6. The draw will take place on the last Friday of the month.
7. The results of the draw will be published in the school's newsletter, Rosebery News. The winner will be notified in writing and prize money paid immediately following each draw.
8. If the Rosebery 100 Club is closed, any contributions paid in advance which have not been included in a draw will be refunded to members. Subscriptions will not be refunded under any other circumstances.
9. Any disputes will be resolved by the PSA Committee whose decision is final.

The Administrator of the 100 Club, appointed by the PSA Committee is Lesley Broome. A further signatory is Rob Mayo, Treasurer of the PSA.
