Cost:	In order to finance this trip, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.00 per pupil. Please note that should we not get enough contributions then the trip will not go ahead
Dress code:	School uniform, we will be departing during Period 4 of the school day.

We will allow the students some time to eat lunch before we depart but please note that they may wish to bring spending money for refreshments/sweets/ice cream at the theatre.
